

## NOELEEN'S SCARF in loop stitch

### Materials:

100g 8ply acrylic

2 x 50g balls of "feathers"

pr of 10mm knitting needles



Using a strand each of feathers and 8ply together, cast on 13sts.

**Special note:** Knit into the back of the first stitch in **every** row.

Knit 3 rows.

**\*\* Next row.** Winding the yarn twice around the needle, knit all along the row.

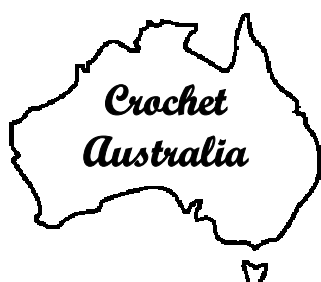
**Next row.** Knit, dropping the extra loop as you go. (13sts)

Knit 2 rows. **\*\***

Repeat from **\*\*** to **\*\***. This is the repeat throughout.

Continue in this manner until the scarf is long enough or until the two balls of feathers yarn are used up, ending with the 2 knit rows. Cast off.

Noeleen's design is beautiful. It is worked using 8ply acrylic to tone with the feathers.
