Remember the old weaving looms......square wooden frames with rusty nails. A little hard to use and even harder to remove the work.



Well they have had a make-over. The Butterfly Loom is Australian designed, owned and invented.

The Butterfly Loom is a wooden hand held device, which comes in four square sizes from 7.5cm to 40cm, and a rectangular size to suit coat-hanger covers. Looms come with full instructions, hints for projects and a needle.





Squares are easily made by winding the yarn around the loom and knotting at each intersection, then

flick the arm at the back of the Butterfly Loom, releasing the finished square. Once you have



made the squares from yarn on the loom, join them together to make a variety of pieces such as make rugs, placemats, jackets, scarves, ponchos, bags, coat-hanger covers, in fact just about anything you



Use any yarns, ribbons or combinations of yarns and colours for great effects. Children to Grannies love to loom, it is quick and easy, and those with arthritis are finding that once again they

are able to craft with yarn. If you can wind it, you can use it with the loom!




Mum made HSV her very own rug in the same colours as Robert's. She just loves it!!
