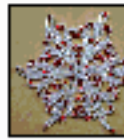

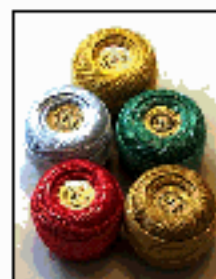

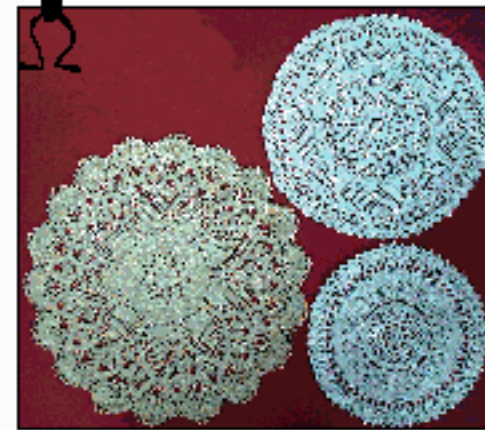


Masterpieces of the Month

ANNETTE P - LORN, NSW has sent us a picture of the slippers she crocheted from the April 04 edition of *Hooked on Crochet*.



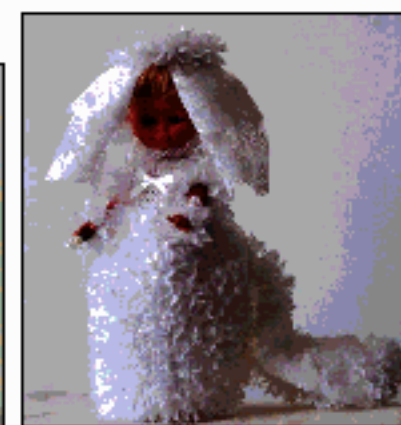
Thanks Annette (surely I could get away with wearing slippers to work if they were crocheted. I could call it promotional attire!)
