Up to now we have stocked 4ply in Milford and Clever Country. There has been a demand for a 4ply thread which is thicker than Milford, but thinner than Clever Country 4ply.

We are pleased to announce that we now stock the full range of Panda Regal which come in 6 variegated (includes the popular red/green/white in time for xmas) and 22 plain colours.

For those of you who loved 4ply Cotton Fields before it was discontinued, this a very similar product.

Comes in 50g balls (165mt) and uses a 2.5mm/3.00mm hook. Only \$3.25 per ball.

CROCHET CRISIS

• Recently a customer bought ASNI 339

"Afghans to Crochet in one day" which used a
"Q" hook and bulky weight yarn. She asked us which
yarn she should use for this project.

A - We suggested a couple of alternatives for her to try so that she could achieve the desired effect. This customer found that the "Q" hook worked well for her if she used 2 strands of 8ply yarn together.

Everyone's tension is different, so it is a good idea to play around with different yarns when using American afghan patterns.

Remember to take the yam from the inside of the ball or you will get yourself in a real pickle!







back though as I missed my puppy dogs immensely.


