for your group to visit, we'd love to meet you and show you our crochet paradise!



Linen hankies with a lace edge, or others crocheted with a crinoline doll or butterfly in one corner.


Just arrived we have spoked monogram hankies for that special person, with an embroidered letter in lilac or pink surrounded by a garland of flowers.
