### PRODUCT OF THE MONTH

## 4 & 8 PLY COTTONS

4ply cotton comes in a variety of thicknesses and quality. Our most popular 4ply *Clever Country* comes in 104 colours. This yarn is a little thicker than other 4plys, approx 148m per ball, but is a dream to crochet and the finished article has plenty of body.



Milford is one of the original 4plys and although a little thinner, approx 226m per ball, it has 46 colours to choose from and has been a favourite for crocheters for many years.

Panda Regal is a middle of the road quality, very similar to the old Cotton Fields that we all loved to crochet our towel tops with and comes in 28 colours. Approx 165m per ball.

Pellicano and Madame Tricot Perle 5 are very popular yarns and on the thickness scale would be approx 3ply but a more mercerised yarn, hence the shine. The Madame Tricot Perle 5 has some brilliant colours that compliment the Pellicano range.



colours that compliment the Pellicano range, between the two ranges there are over 50 colours to choose from. Approx 210m per ball.

There are other 4plys on the market but we feel the cottons we stock are good quality for a fair price, all designed for craft and garment crochet.



For those wanting a thicker yarn, we have *Heirloom 8ply* and *Camilla 8ply*, both these yarns are great for garment crochet, especially hats, bags and vests.



We have many towel, bag and garment crochet books available to choose from


