

PRODUCT OF THE MONTH

Madame Tricote Perle 5

Madame Tricote Perle 5 Crochet Cotton - 50g ball

This is a quality Ne5/2 100% cotton thread, mercerized and gassed, which we have imported from Turkey to complement the Coats "Pellicano" Perle 5 range.

Madame Tricote Perle 5 is available in 35 plain, 15 variegated and 10 metallic colours (with silver or gold metallic highlight thread) in a 50g ball with an approximate length of 210m. This thread is the same thickness as Coats "Pellicano", thinner than "Regal" and "Clever Country" 4Ply and slightly thicker than "Milford" 4Ply cotton, so is suitable for projects using these threads.

Most crochet cottons today are "mercerized" which means they have been treated with an acid solution to expand the fibres and allow better penetration of the dyes which produces a slight sheen. The more expensive cottons are double mercerized. Perle cottons are mercerized then "gassed" which involves passing the thread quickly through a flame which removes any fluffy bits and makes the thread appear iridescent.

Perle cottons are normally associated with embroidery as they are softer and exhibit a high lustre and brilliance of colours, but today perle cottons are becoming less expensive and therefore suitable for many crochet projects.

The crochet sampler displayed in photo belongs to my Grandmother. She was born in 1885. It was she who taught me to crochet more than 50 years ago. She also taught me how to do 'Hairpin' Lace and I still have my 1st effort at a D'oiley. All the work attached, was worked either by candlelight or Kerosene Lamp. Considering that most of the thread used was '150', '120' & '100' - its amazing that at 79 years, just before she passed away she was still crocheting fine d'oileys for grandchildren and great grandchildren. When I was 10 she detached a piece and gave it to me to keep (it was the fillet 'cat' because I'm a cat fanatic) How I treasured it and worked to attain her high standard of craftsmanship. I thought that the sampler was either lost or destroyed many years ago, so imagine my delight when my one remaining elderly (85) aunt bought it out and asked me if I knew what it was! "Even better" - I said, "I have the piece that was attached THERE." I feel honoured

that I have been entrusted with this 'history of crochet', of which, some pieces would be more than 100 years old Following our family tradition I have taught my two daughters to crochet; and so next I hope to teach my three grand-daughters to crochet too. BETH T - MORWELL, VIC

HILDA J - DALBY, QLD comes to visit the group from time to time and has just finished this eye catching rug!


