elcome to the August 2007 newsletter!!


There's so much to tell you about this month I just don't know where to start!! So prepare for information overload!

Aren't they just adorable!


Monica used patterns from 875554 Beautiful Baby Boutique and 4ply wool. She said that it was easy to make and she really loved how it turned out.
