
We did not realize that we had so many different items available as sets until today. Yes we have crochet hook sets of many brands





This eye catching Swirl Centre is from a Twilleys Leaflet no 6007 (SHBK3343-1) and was done in Coats Mercer crochet cotton.




Check out the ruffles on this one! This ruffled Centre is from Crochet Monthly no 161 (no longer available)


