white, cream, lemon, aqua, chili red (terracotta), lemon, hot pink, brown, sage green, navy and have matching face washers to complement them.




We have sourced a supply of novelty children's face washers with fun marine themes and ladies face cloths with floral designs - roses, pansies and lavender.

Monique used our Crochet Kit 046 which contains the pattern, doll and thread to complete the pincushion.




If you are a knitter then try knitted patterns from either WEN4631 Fashion Doll Outfits o**r ASN1420** Fashion Doll Knits.


