Great at a later date as a refresher course when the memory bank cannot recall that vital piece of information you need to complete the task at hand.





#### HANDY HINTS



Having trouble with damaged crochet hooks......or are you constantly rummaging through that container trying to find that hook that you know is there......somewhere?

Keeping your crochet hooks in tip top condition is as simple as rinsing and drying them after each use. Our hands contain oils and acid and after a brief period of time the metal finish will begin to deteriorate. For storage, a pouch with separate compartments for each hook is better than the hooks all tossed together into a pencil / glasses case, toothbrush container or any of the various containers that we tend to use. When your precious crochet hooks are loose, the constant friction between them may chip the anodized / nickel coating.

### Masterpieces of the Month





