hello again to scarves, beanies and hats. Year after year they are always the popular accessory to brighten any winter outfit. Sometimes these are a real show stopper or fashion statement, but for most us they are just the best way to keep the winter chills at bay.





Scarves can be simple with the yarn being the commanding theme. I saw an interesting one the other day and it was merely a very lengthy piece worked on a hair pin frame. Scarves are no longer the striped rows of rib. We add flowers, feathers, buttons and bows. My favourite is the Florbunda Scarf (GC08105 - \$10.00)

We have lots of books on scarves, beanies and hats. We have included a short list on page 5 for you to peruse. One of my favourite beanies is the one that starts at the crown and is worked in continuous rounds. We have beanies for babies, kiddles and

#### Storing your crocheting.

Store small crocheted items by wrapping in acid free white tissue paper or in an old cotton pillow case. Larger items should be folded loosely between layers of white tissue paper, ensuring each fold is padded with tissue paper. Store the items in a drawer or other dark, dry moth proof place. 




I love them. You are so kind to give me a nice free book and a free magazine in the previous parcel. God bless you!

We do not have this pattern but have other filet books with cherubs, such as CORTI 03 CORTI 04 and SELEC 30.




