


lettuce plants though. The 5 day break has been a good time to catch up on the weeding and more planning in the garden. All this has to be good for the soul, but not necessarily the back!

Renate Kirkpatrick and Prudence Mapstone have embraced this style with tremendous passion. They have shown us all, that regardless of your knitting and crochet ability, by combining lots of colour, textures of yarn, structured motifs, bits that take on any form, that when sewn together can make wonderful articles of clothing and accessories – bags, scarves, hats, vests, jackets, belts, necklaces, bracelets, etc.



Basically there are no rules to scrumbling. So maybe it is time to take yourself on a journey with lots of colour and texture to create your own art forms. Even though anything goes, including weaving and embroidery if you choose, beading and bullion,
