Motifs in knit and crochet



Do you remember your first motif? For most of us it would have been the humble granny square. These days we see motifs in many shapes and sizes -

squares, circles, triangles, octagon, hexagon, flowers, hearts, butterflies, pictured squares and now with the popularity of freeform crochet you can have any motif your crochet hook or needle produces, as the rules have been put aside in the name of art.



Alas, there are knitted motifs that are usually blocks of all over designs and tatted motifs that appear in books as snowflakes. Whether you work with the thicker yarns or the finer threads, the combination of these motifs is used to produce afghan



rugs, pillows, hats, scarves, bags, garments, doilies, tablecloths and runners, tea towel tops and more. Add lots of colour and imagination to your motifs

Thank you for your very prompt service in sending the books I ordered and also the little surprise of a lovely chocky frog. Yum. I have browsed through the books and am very interested in getting

a little bit of practice in using the Knook. My daughter is pleased with the pattern for the "Eternity Scarf". I have been practising with the knooking hook, nylon thread and wool, and have been pleasantly surprised at the work



that I am able to do. In the book it shows how to hold the needle and work to start the knitting, but I had watched an Italian friend crocheting with a knitting method, where she holds both wool and needle in her right hand and supports her work with her left. I am using this method to do the Knooking but using the book to still follow the directions that the needle has to go to produce the knit stitch and the purl stitch. Hope this method will be of use, as I find it easier to do. I have found that the wool works itself around the needle in the same direction as shown in the book.
