#### **Afghans and Throws**

The predicted cold winter has been the inspiration for this month's theme – afghans and throws. The perfect accompaniment for



any cold weather is a good afghan, blanket, throw, rug — whatever you wish to call them! Make one for the bed, lounge, car, pram, cot, taking to the park or travelling, and you can't go wrong. And of course you can't forget your pets. My dog just loves to snuggle into her dog rug during these cool nights.

There are endless patterns and colours available to enable you to make truly one of a kind blankets. Sampler blankets are also good and proving quite popular this year – giving you a chance to try out new stitches. Making small squares also makes it a more portable project so you can never be without your crochet. Or make one using up your stash – I've seen many a colourful blanket made from using up the leftovers from other projects.

Afghans can be made from any yarn – acrylic makes a warm and economical blanket that is very easy to care for – try out our 8ply dazzle which is very soft and cozy or Peter Pan baby yarn for extra softness. For extra warmth in those cooler climates use wool – the 8ply Loyal wool is soft and has a marvellous colour range. Or if you are lucky enough to live in one of those places that doesn't get so cold, try cotton - 8ply Heirloom or Catona, Catona denim or the cotton/acrylic blend in the stonewash make excellent lightweight blankets.

Check out our selection of patterns, tools and yarns, in the next sections, along with the new afghan books out this month – you are bound to find something that suits. A very popular pattern has been the <u>diamond</u> granny throw. I haven't

found any books on it yet, but you could try the free pattern to learn this new popular technique.

# Tip of the Month Blanket Sizes



Two questions I often get are—what size is a particular blanket and how much yarn do I need? I had always expected the first question would be easy to answer, but this is actually not the case. Every book and designer use different sizes for the same type of blanket. The amount of yarn is dependent not only on the size, but whether you want drape, the weight of the yarn and the type of pattern—whether dense or lacey. I pulled together the following chart of common sizes and average yarn based on no drape and a simple pattern for a blanket.

|               | Size - no drape<br>(cm) | 4 ply yarn<br>(metres) | 8 ply yarn<br>(metres) |
|---------------|-------------------------|------------------------|------------------------|
| Baby          | 90 x 90                 | 1500                   | 1000                   |
| Toddler       | 90 x 120                | 1900                   | 1500                   |
| Lap           | 70 x 90                 | 1400                   | 900                    |
| Throw/ Single | 120 x 160               | 3000                   | 2600                   |
| Double        | 130 x 180               | 4000                   | 3300                   |
| Queen         | 180 x 190               | 4500                   | 3900                   |
| King          | 190 x 190               | 4700                   | 4100                   |

#### LA4382 50 Crocheted Afghan Borders \$22.50



Have you ever completed an afghan and thought there was just something missing? It was really pretty but...well, it seemed to need something else and it wasn't fringe! What that afghan probably needed was a border. And this book gives you 50 of them, which can be added to just about any afghan, whether it's knitted or crocheted, to provide the finishing touch. Some of the borders are wide and ruffled, some are narrow and tailored. Others are very feminine, some are more masculine. All of them are fun to work and will turn the plainest afghan into something very special. Patterns could also be used for towel edges.
