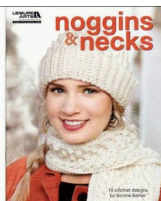

Crocheted the vintage doily edging using the cotton hemstitched circular doily



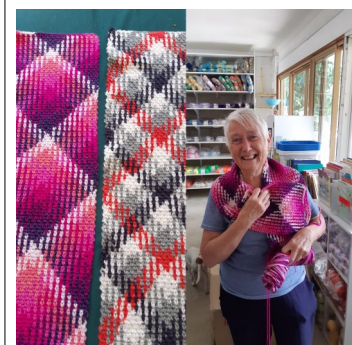
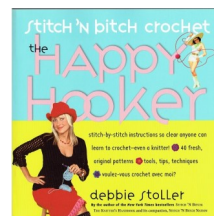
Chris G, Summerland Point, NSW

Was very pleased to have mastered pooling in our March workshop to complete this scarf, as were other attendees



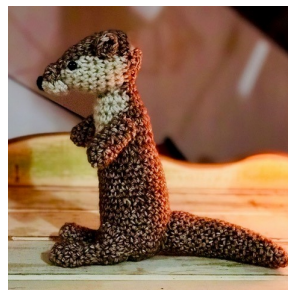

Crocheted this filet pattern using Babylo #10 cotton



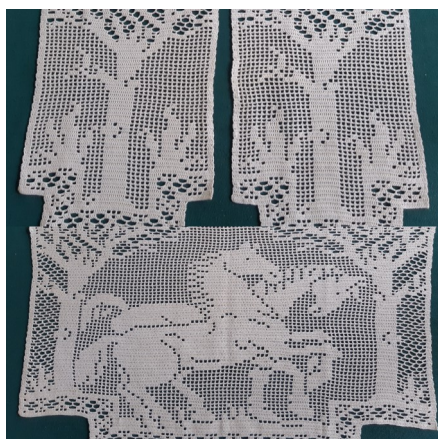


Workshop attendees modelling their hats made at the February workshop - just in time to see through the end of summer. All made with Scheepjes Catona Denim 8 ply cotton.

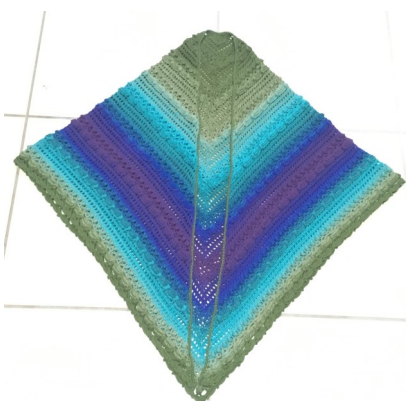
Crocheted this charity blanket made with Dazzle 8 ply acrylic

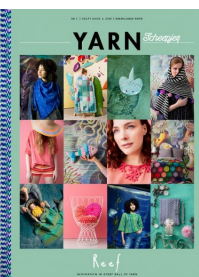
